Twenty-six former USAs had made reservations and more than 40 regret letters were received.

The organizers approved a not-for-profit charter which grants life membership to all former Presidentially commissioned USAs, Associate membership to Department of Justice persons who have served under a Presidential commission and to court appointed former USAs.

The charter provides for a fifteen (15) member Board of Directors not more than three (3) of whom shall be from any single Federal judicial circuit. The initial board is composed of the following with their term of office indicated:
